  - Sign up to receive Alert and Advisory messages by texting the zip code 99664 to the number 888777
  
- Police Department
  - Inbound calls to Seward 911 or Seward dispatch that require in person response will be required to answer screening questions to enable responders to adequately prepare
  
- He Will Provide Food Shelter
  - Open Thursdays from 3-6 pm; pre-filled bags of food being delivered outside the facility; clients may notice a shift to receiving more staples than previously
  - Gave out 105 bags last Thursday (up from 97 the week before)
  - Questions or concerns contact President Mike Little at 769-1395
  
- Safeway
  - Store hours changed to: 6:00 am – 10:00 pm Daily
  - Special shopping time reserved for elders, pregnant women, and compromised immune system individuals from 7-9 am on Tuesdays & Thursdays
  - Still having some issues getting basic staples: rice, flour, sugar, toilet paper; no concerns on other supplies; shipments daily
  
- Pharmacy at Safeway
  - Hours, Mon-Sat 9 am – 7 pm **PLUS** special Pharmacy hours on Tuesdays & Thursdays from 7-9 am to coincide with Safeway's special shopping reserved hours
  - Prescription delivery is available; requests received by 1 pm will be delivered the same day; call 224-6960 to sign up
  - No supply chain concerns
  
- Seward Marketplace
  - Open for business as usual
  - Have some toilet paper and paper towels on hand from last Friday's shipment
  - Expecting a shipment tomorrow
  
- Frontier Trading Post
  - Open for business
  
- Alaska Waste
  - Normal operations
